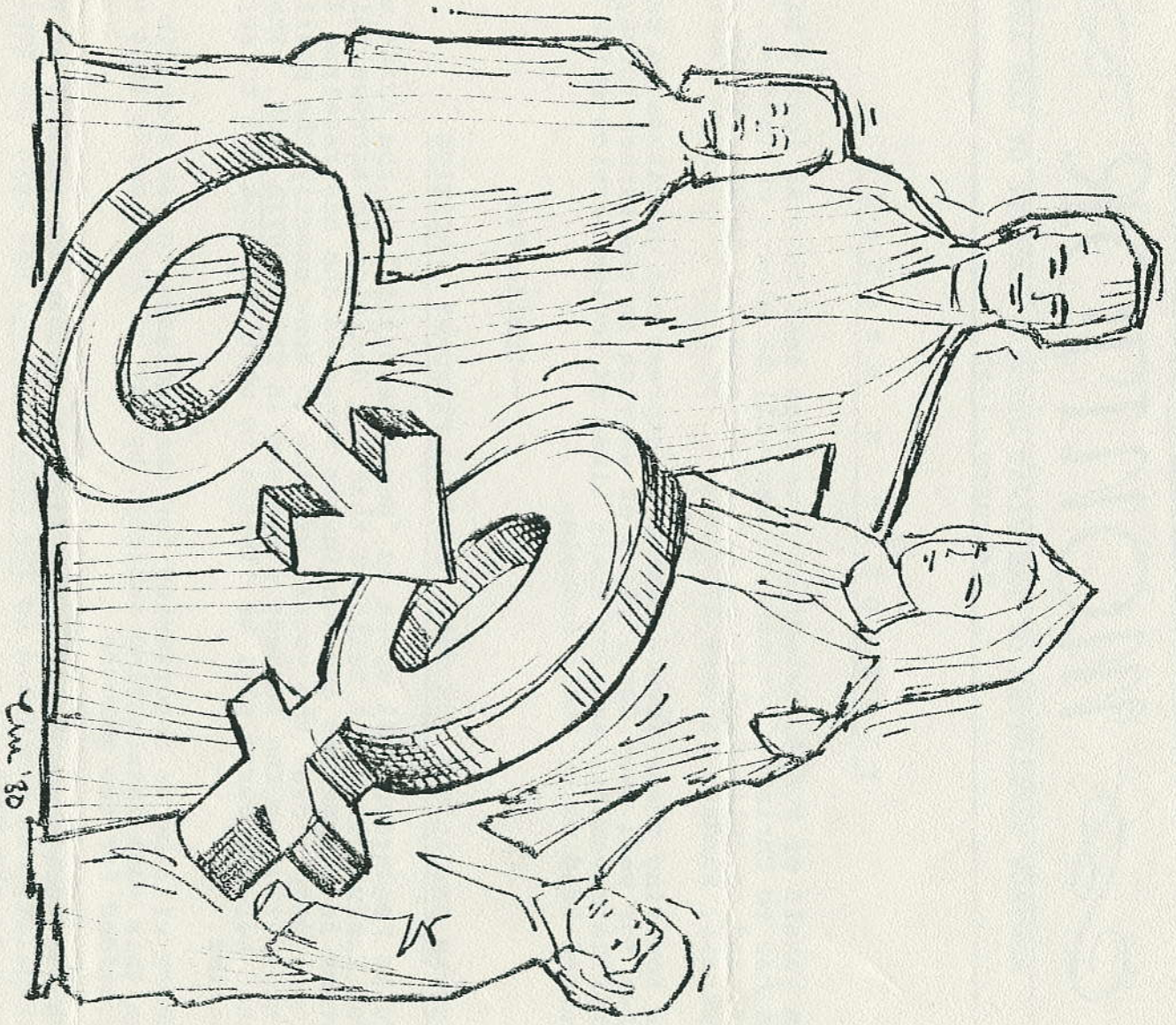
There will be an opportunity for the audience to ask specific questions on this most interesting subject, by way of 3"x5" cards that will be provided for the purpose.
