GUEST SPEAKERS SLATED FOR JULIA'S MARRIAGE AND FAMILY CLASSES

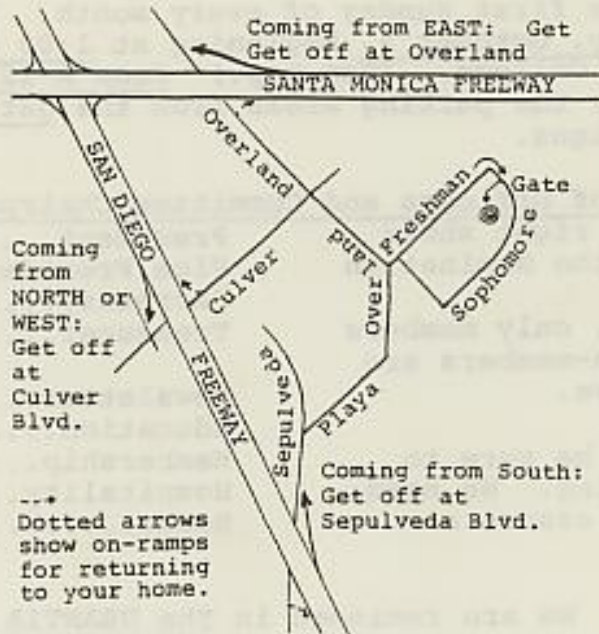
